- Providing a lumber liquidators \$1000.00 gift certificate to restore a floor in a flooded home
- Purchased a fuel oil hot air furnace for another flooded out home.
- Bought an electric service panel, supplies, and paid for the installation to restore power to a home.
- Provided a \$1000.00 Lowes gift certificate to a family with two floors flooded in their home.
- Gave a \$1000.00 Lowes gift certificate to a family living in their garage, to get them back into their home.
- Donated \$1000.00 to "Fields of Grace" ministry, to purchase sheet rock for flooded homes.
- Donated \$500.00 to North Blenheim Methodist church to assist in flood recovery efforts.

- Coordinating work teams and skilled tradesmen to volunteer in home restoration.
- Provide fuel for a truck driver to pick up and deliver several flatbed loads of building supplies.
- Connecting with local and state pastors to raise awareness of the damage and how to help.
- Coordinating with local and out of the area pastors to send volunteers.
- Provide encouragement and prayer to flood zone pastors while working in communities and along side local pastors.
- Launched a facebook site for Three Strands Ministry as a point of contact and information exchange.
- Restored a damaged driveway for an elderly lady in Middleburgh
- Gave several appliances to a flood zone home.
